Eligibility:

Candidates who have completed a one year / 2 semester master's degree programme after a four year / bachelor degree programme OR a two year / master degree programme after a three-year bachelor degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree OR a M.Phil. degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed.

A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently abled, economically weaker section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of UGC from time to time.

NET qualified candidates do not have to appear in RET written examination but have to appear in RET Viva exam.

Moreover, the University is pleased to announce that a limited number of full time SVU Fellowship (JRF) and full time post-doctoral Fellowships, as per SVU regulations, will be offered strictly on the basis of merit across departments.
