A Gateway to India's Innovation Ecosystem

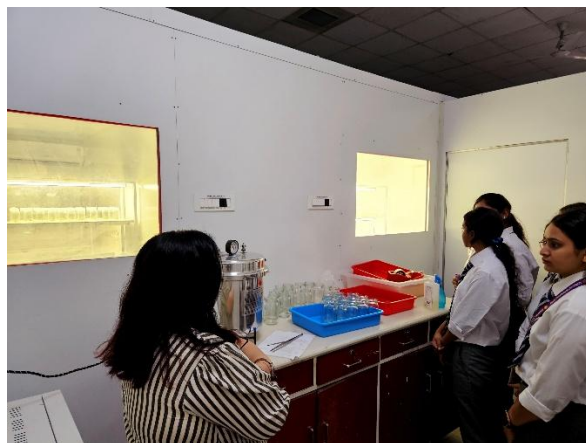
