Workshop on How to write a Research Article

1. Workshop Objectives and Outcomes

Day 3: Writing the Discussion and Conclusion

Instructor: Dr. Mohammad Niyaz Ahmad The session emphasised interpreting results, acknowledging study limitations, and critically analysing findings. Participants worked on summarising contributions, outlining practical implications, and avoiding overgeneralisation in their conclusions.

Day 4: Research Methodology, Sampling, and Statistical Analysis Tools

Instructor: Dr. Anirban Hazra The session provided insights into research methodologies, sampling techniques, and data analysis. Participants were introduced to statistical tools, including SPSS, Excel, and R, and learned effective data visualisation methods.

Day 5: Use of Software Tools and Finalising Research Papers

Instructor: Prof. Kallal Banerjee The final session covered the use of software tools like Excel, SPSS, and ANOVA for statistical analysis. Additionally, guidance was provided on selecting the right journal, preparing a submission package, responding to peer reviews, and handling rejection.

3. Closing Session: Q&A, Networking, and Future Steps

The workshop concluded with an open Q&A session where participants addressed doubts and shared their progress. Networking opportunities facilitated peer interaction, and additional resources, including suggested readings and online workshops, were provided for continued learning.
