



(57) Abstract : This work seeks to analyze the amount of time students spend reading newspapers with the objective of enhancing their English communication skills. Taking into account the high demand for English language proficiency in an ever-globalizing world, students consider newspapers as a reliable source of language acquisition. Thus, studying the amount of time students dedicate to reading newspapers enables the assessment of to what extent this activity influences their English communication proficiency. By using both quantitative and qualitative methods, the study will assess the amount of time students speed reading newspapers compared to other activities as well as their perceptions about the level of improvement or decine of their English communication. Moreover, it will also explore if there are any differences in the amount of time and results depending on the student's gender, age, socio-cultural background, and educational level. The findings of this study can be used to shape resources and strategies that could enhance student's proficiency in English language communication.
